



How do artists use line to create shapes and textures?







VOCABULARY



Line: can be horizontal, vertical or diagonal, straight or curved, thick or thin. They help us understand a piece of art.



Texture: the way a surface looks in a work of art linked with how they look or would feel if we touched them.



Shape: a line that is joined with no gaps



Organic: not perfect lines or shapes, often curved and flowing.



Geometric: shapes made from points and lines including shapes such as triangle, square and circle.
