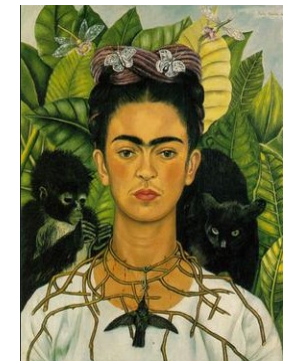

The colours give the impression of a happier time in his life although his facial expression is sad.

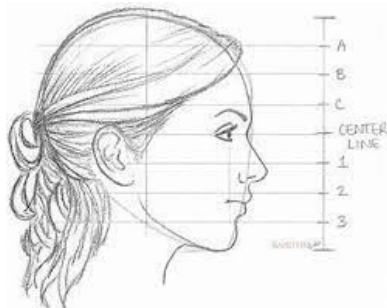
Picasso

During Picasso's Blue Period he created emotion through colour. Here, he used different shades of blue to show his sadness.

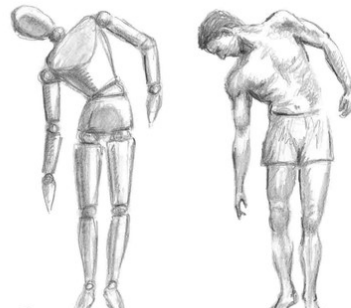
Frida Kahlo
