Families will...

- Send their child to school each day on time.

- Ensure any food provided (packed lunches/snacks) is nutritiously balanced and healthy.
- Monitor their child's activity online to keep them safe.
- Be responsible for their child's safety before and after school whilst on the school premises.
- Keep the office informed of up-to-date contact details.
- Send any reply slips back promptly.
- Speak courteously to staff members and each other at all times.
